VICTORIAN DOWNHILL SERIES ROUND 2-TAKE 2




This year we elevated our Event delivery by hosting a round of the VDHS at Mt Taylor. After the need to cancel initially due to extreme weather, the big decision was taken to reschedule and do all the organising again. Luckily the second time around the weather was perfect, all the planning worked, volunteer support was amazing and racers appreciated the venue. A very big thanks to everyone involved, but particularly to Jacinta Nelsson and Jake Matthews for leading the delivery of the event. Not only did we learn a great deal along the way, but we are also better positioned now to do this again into the future. MT TAYLOR SKILLS PARK PROJECT

Funding of \$360,030 for the Mt Taylor Skills Park Project was provided by the Australian Government through the Black Summer Bushfires Recovery Program. After officially opening the Skills Park in October 2023, works at the site are complete and the requirements associated with the funding have now been concluded. Our aim was to create a riding experience for all riding abilities at Mt Taylor, addressing a range of safety challenges at the base, while also creating a better environment for visitors, families and users of the facilities.
